This memorable tour includes: a **45-minute** audio presentation called 'Doing Time: The Alcatraz Prison Tour,' featuring prison guards and prisoners who lived and worked on the island; a video guide and historical documentary; walks through the historic gardens; and a chance to see the island's wildlife.

Alcatraz and history go hand in hand. Once home to some of America's most dangerous criminals, the federal prison that operated here from 1934 to 1963 gave "the Rock" a dark, mysterious and dangerous aura. The presence of infamous criminals like Al "Scarface" Capone, America's most famous gangster, helped to establish the island's legendary reputation.

To this day, Alcatraz is best known as one of the world's most legendary prisons. Many people, though, are unaware of the wealth of other history on the island. Alcatraz is now home to rare flowers and plants, wildlife on land and in the waters of the bay, and thousands of sea birds. Civil War-era buildings across the island give insight into the 19th century, when the island served as both a defence fort and a military prison. You can also see remains of the American Indian Occupation that started in 1969 after the prison closed, marking an important event in the history of the American Indian rights movement.
